## **ENROLLMENT 2022-23**

"We have now begun the 2022-2023 NEW STUDENT enrollment process. We are now accepting applications for NEW siblings (including kindergarten students) and transfers. Please remember that new kindergarten students must be 5 on or before September 1st to qualify for enrollment; there are no exceptions to this rule. Lotteries will begin on January 3rd so make sure you have completed the application prior to then to increase the likelihood of receiving your priority enrollment status. # SCHOOL CLOSURES WITH WINTER QUICKLY APPROACHING: - FROM THE PARENT STUDENT HANDBOOK—

American Prep follows Canyons School District (CSD) with regard to school closures due to inclement weather or emergencies. Parents should listen to these designated radio or television stations for school closure information between the hours of 6-8 am. If school for CSD is cancelled, school at American Prep will be cancelled. If there is a late start for CSD, we will have the late start at American Prep. If only selected schools in CSD are closed or have a late start schedule, American Prep will operate as NORMAL. Parents are ultimately responsible for deciding if inclement weather is severe enough that they cannot drive to school. (If schools dismiss early, the media will air the announcement as soon as possible.) If CSD dismisses early, American Prep will dismiss early.
