"We have now begun the 2022-2023 NEW STUDENT enrollment process. We are now accepting applications for NEW siblings (including kindergarten students) and transfers. Please remember that new kindergarten students must be 5 on or before September 1st to qualify for enrollment; there are no exceptions to this rule. Lotteries will begin on January 3rd so make sure you have completed the application prior to then to increase the likelihood of receiving your priority enrollment status. Please visit www.americanprep.org/enrollment to complete the application.

CLEANING OUT YOUR STUDENT'S DOCKET:

Parents, we hope to clear up any confusion concerning your student's docket. The docket contains several colored file folders representing the following subjects.

Plain Manila Folder: TAKE HOME FOLDER Red - Reading Yellow - Math Green - Science Blue - History Purple - Language Arts

Gray - Reading University Orange - Spelling

We have instructed our teachers and instructors to please mark a star on the top of all papers and place them in the "TAKE HOME FOLDER". This will indicate to our parents that these papers have been reviewed and can stay at home. These papers should be taken out of the dockets and keep at home. If the student has homework, these papers will be in the proper labeled folder; i.e. math homework will be in the yellow math folder, etc.

One purpose of the docket is to help American Prep implement a "no loose papers" policy. All papers should be placed in the correct file folder inside the docket. That way, students always have what they need with them in class and at home. Please remove all stickers from the outside of your student's docket. We love that our students are learning the importance of organization and being responsible for their own paperwork and homework.

SCHOOL CLOSURES WITH WINTER QUICKLY APPROACHING: - FROM THE PARENT STUDENT HANDBOOK—

American Prep follows Canyons School District (CSD) with regard to school closures due to inclement weather or emergencies. Parents should listen to these designated radio or television stations for school closure information between the hours of 6-8 am. If school for CSD is cancelled, school at American Prep will be cancelled. If there is a late start for CSD, we will have the late start at American Prep. If only selected schools in CSD are closed or have a late start schedule, American Prep will operate as NORMAL. Parents are ultimately responsible for deciding if inclement weather is severe enough that they cannot drive to school. (If schools dismiss early, the media will air the announcement as soon as possible.) If CSD dismisses early, American Prep will dismiss early.
