**AM/PM and FULL DAY KINDERGARTEN SCHEDULE:**

At the end of June a notification went out confirming your student’s AM, PM or FULL DAY schedule. Just a reminder:

- AM students can be dropped off as early as 8:00 am, school starts at 8:30. Pick up is at 11:30, M-F.
- PM students can be dropped off as early as 11:45 am, school starts at 12:00. Pick up is at 3:00, M-F.
- FULL students can be dropped off as early as 8:00 am, school starts at 8:30. Pick up is at 3:00 M-F.
  - Payment information for FULL day students was sent in an email last week from Ms. Miles.

We understand there are multiple families still on waiting lists for either the FULL day or the AM session. We are doing the best to accommodate those families. **PARENT ORIENTATION**

**Date:** Thursday, August 18<sup>th</sup>  
**Time:** Meeting starts promptly at 6:00pm - 7:00pm  
**Where:** We will be meeting in the gym over at our Draper 1 campus. (12892 S. South Pony Express Rd)  
**What:** At Parent Orientation you will receive detailed information about:

**SCHOOL SUPPLIES:**

You will not need to purchase any school supplies for your students. APA will provide ALL supplies that your student will need except for a backpack. When purchasing your student’s backpack, make sure it is big enough to accommodate our APA docket. A docket is roughly 10x13. Your student will receive their name tag and docket on first week of school.

All students need to come to school with a water bottle and a healthy snack. For full day students please provide a lunch and a snack.



**LUNCH:**

For full day kindergarten you can go onto [americanprep.org](http://americanprep.org) and order your lunch for you student or you are welcome to pack their daily, lunch.

**NO SUGAR ZONE SCHOOL:**

Many of our parents have voiced their desire to have a sugar free school zone. Several years ago we implemented this new policy. We will continue to move forward with a “No Sugar Zone” school year for 2022-2023.

In the past for student’s birthdays, parents have brought in cupcakes, cookies, etc. We ask that if you still desire to bring something in for your student’s birthday, please make it non-food items. Some suggestions might include: stickers, pencils, small toys, donate a book to our library, etc. Thank you for your helping us keep our school a sugar-free zone.
