Lotteries will begin the first week in January so make sure you have completed the application prior to then to increase the likelihood of receiving your priority enrollment status. SCHOOL CLOSURES WITH WINTER QUICKLY APPROACHING - FROM THE PARENT STUDENT HANDBOO

American Prep follows Canyons School District (CSD) with regard to school closures due to inclement weather or emergencies. Parents should listen to these designated radio or television stations for school closure information between the hours of 6-8 am. If school for CSD is cancelled, school at American Prep will be cancelled. If there is a late start for CSD, we will have the late start at American Prep.
